WORLD BOOK DAY

Today we celebrated World Book Day, and took part in lots of fun activities exploring different book genres, such as fantasy, fairy tales, rhymes, information, biographies and mystery. The children all looked fantastic in their costumes and they enjoyed moving around the school to take part in some exciting activities linking to the different genres.

In Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, the children got the chance to rotate around each class and take part in different activities, including:

- Fairy tales Making a fairy tale puppet.
- Non-fiction Making a clay snail.
- Biography (Florence Nightingale) Looking at hospitals now and then.
- Rhyming Stacking rhyming words based on The Cat in the Hat.
- Fantasy Drama.
- Picture books Making a picture book.

Similarly, all children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 visited every teacher to complete the following activities:

- Detective fiction Sherlock Holmes style.
- Sci-Fi Inventing a Worlingham Guide to the Galaxy.
- Play scripts Creating a visual representation of a character following drama through a play script.
- Graphic novels Comic strips.
- Fairy tales with alternative endings.
- Myths and quests.
- Performance poetry.

All pupils will bring home a £1 World Book Day voucher that can used towards a book in participating book shops.
