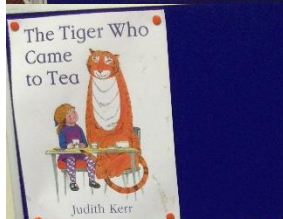
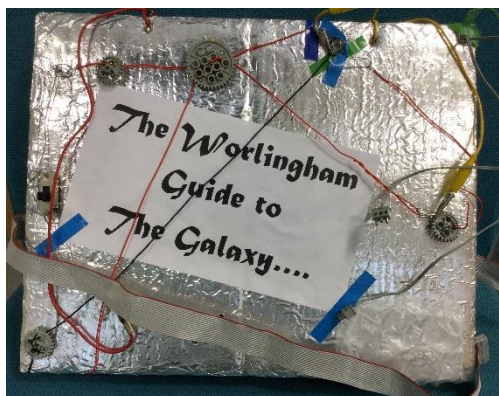
Well done to all who participated and to the Year 5 children who refereed the games.
